


Electra St Uniting Church, Williamstown hosted a very successful Human Rights Day Dinner on the 10th December as a fundraiser for Christmas Bowl. Close to fifty people attended and around \$1100 was raised. An Act for Peace Refugee Ambassador shared his story of becoming a refugee.

On display at the church were photocopies of excerpts from newspapers of the late 1940's and the 1950's with details of the work of Rev Frank Byatt and the early work and success of the Christmas Bowl of Remembrance Appeal. Mr Byatt was the Methodist minister at that church when Christmas Bowl began in 1949 and was its chief instigator. Also on display were photos of the work of Act for Peace partners, as supported by the funds from Christmas Bowl. Is your church doing something special for Christmas Bowl? If so please let us know.
